SHORT TACKS

Fleet 5 Spring Clinic - Thursday May 8th Fleet 5's Spring Clinic will be on Thursday May 8th at 7pm at the CYC, and will feature a panel discussion of the new rules. Our panel this year will be a real treat and is among the more impressive we've ever assembled. Panelist will include former BC sailing team star, CYC team racing skipper and perennial club champion Will Bailey, EYC Sailing Dean and former MIT Sailing Master Franny Charles, and 2-time Olympian in the 49er, Tim Wadlow. They'll discuss the new rules in the context of areas of the course: pre-start / start, upwind / weather mark, and downwind / leeward mark. You won't want to miss this one. Fleet 5 On-the-Water Clinic – As we did last year, the fleet will again hold an on-the-water clinic, led by Joe Fava. Dates and details are still being worked out, so stay tuned.
