Adam Roberts Wins Invitational Cup – 2025 Nationals Champ Adam Roberts, sailing in the role of tactician for his home club of San Diego Yacht Club, finished 1st in the prestigious 2025 Rolex NYYC Invitational Cup, a five-day event that concluded in Newport on Saturday. In a fleet of 20 IC37s, he and his SDYC teammates put up a line of 7-1-1-1-2-8-7-2-1-16-9-8 for 63 points, finishing 5 points in front of Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club in 2nd with 68 points. Well done. Despite the four bullets, a 16th in race 10 put them into a precarious and high-pressure spot going into the final race. In that race, they overcame a bad start and one of the most gnarly weather mark rounds you'll ever see, to tough it out from 17th all the way back to 8th, putting them atop the podium for the second consecutive running of this event. Rounding out the podium was Royal Vancouver Yacht Club in 3rd with 70.1 points, our own Corinthian Yacht Club in 4th with 80 points, and Royal Cork Yacht Club in 5th with 93 points. Our other 2025 National Champ Alden Reid also participated, sailing for Eastern Yacht Club who finished 10th with 109 points. Congrats to Adam, Alden, Team CYC for their second straight podium in this event, and all of Marblehead's finest for showing the flag. You'll find results and more info here.

Organized by Sail Newport, the Newport Regatta is a mainstay of the Newport One Design calendar, typically averaging 14 one design classes across four lines.
